It gives me immense pleasure to invite you to the 38th Surajkund International Crafts Mela, 2025 to be held from 7th-23rd February-2025 at Surajkund, Faridabad (Haryana).

As you are aware, the Mela, which is jointly hosted by Union Ministries of Tourism & Culture; External Affairs; Textiles; ICCR and the Govt. of Haryana, showcases the finest traditions of handicrafts, handlooms, culture and cuisine across India as well as other countries. Over the years, the Mela has come to occupy a place of pride and prominence in the region's tourism calendar. With the help of MEA, more than 45 Countries with 592 foreign artists participated in the 37th Surajkund Mela-2024, which attracted over 13 lakh visitors.
