

## Undertaking by OCI applicant regarding Indian voter ID etc

I, \_\_\_\_\_, Current PP No.: \_\_\_\_\_(and former Indian Passport No. \_\_\_\_\_ if applicable) understand the process of OCI registration and also understand that *the OCI Cardholder is not entitled to vote, be it for a member of Legislative Assembly or Legislative Council, or for Parliament. I also know that I cannot hold Indian Constitutional Posts such as President, Vice President, Judge of Supreme Court or High Court etc. as specified in section 7B(2) of The Citizenship Act, 1955. I recognize that as an OCI Cardholder, I shall not be entitled for appointment to public services and posts in connection with the work of the Union of India or of any State of India except for appointment in such services and posts as the Central Government may, by special order, in that behalf specify. Further, as an OCI Cardholder, I recognize that I cannot acquire agricultural land or farmhouse or plantation properties in India.*

2. I, therefore, understand that I am also not entitled to hold a voter ID card, a Ration card or any such document which only Indian Citizens are entitled to hold. I hereby declare that I have surrendered all such documents that are solely for Indian Citizens.

3. In case if Indian government authorities find that I continue to hold such documents or have misrepresented or suppressed material facts, I understand that necessary action can be initiated against me, which may also include cancellation of my OCI Card and blacklisting me for any future travel to India.
