

Re-Issuance of International Driving Permit

IDP helps the Indian Citizen to drive vehicle which is allowed to drive as per Indian Driving License, in foreign countries which are the signatory of Geneva Convention on Road Traffic, 1949.

Please send your application by post (Special Delivery/Registered Post only) to the Consulate General of India, Birmingham (CGI) at following address:

Requirements: Please note carefully to enclose following documents along with the application while sending it by post to the CGI.

- 1 Miscellaneous Application Form : Miscellaneous Application form duly filled in and signed by the applicant (Please click for Miscellaneous Application Form or please visit the link 'Forms for Consular Services').
2. One recent Passport size photograph to be affixed on the Misc. Application form.
3. Self attested photo copies of first two and last two pages of the passport and the page(s) containing passport officer's observation(s) (if any).
4. Please send self – addressed (mention complete address including post code) special delivery envelop with postage stamps to return your documents.
5. Proof of Residence : Any of the following self attested documents i.e., copy of utility bill (Latest landline telephone bill / gas bill / water bill or Council Tax bill) or lease deed (of residence) etc. where the applicant's UK address is clearly mentioned should be provided.
6. Visa Status: Self-attested copy of passport page / UK Residence Permit Card showing the visa status should be enclosed.

7. Fee: GBP 17.00 (payable by crossed postal order drawn in favour of “Consulate General of India, Birmingham”).

8. All photocopies of documents must be self-attested by the respective person. You are requested to ensure that you comply with all the documentation needed for the particular service sought.

9. Please note if the application is received incomplete / deficient then, the documents would be returned by the Consulate General of India. The applicant would solely be responsible for any delay / damage arising out of this.

Note : The above are the general mandatory requirements. The applicant may be advised to submit some more documents, after scrutiny of the application and documents at the Consular Section on case to case basis.

Applicant will apply for fresh issue of IDP through the portal www.parivahan.gov.in and will upload the documents, including the receipt / documents issued by Consulate General of India as mandated under the Central Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989. On receipt of through the portal, the licensing authority, on verification of the documents, shall issue the IDP and shall courier it directly to the address of the applicant.

CHECK LIST / ORDER OF DOCUMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL DRIVING PERMIT

1. Miscellaneous service form duly signed with one passport sized photograph on top and right hand side of the form.

2. Photo copy of applicant's Valid passport /s (Copy must be self – attested) copies of first two pages and last two pages duly self attested.

3. Self attested copy of Applicant's proof of address (Any utility bill like light, gas or water bill or Council tax bill).

All photocopies must be self attested by the respective person.
